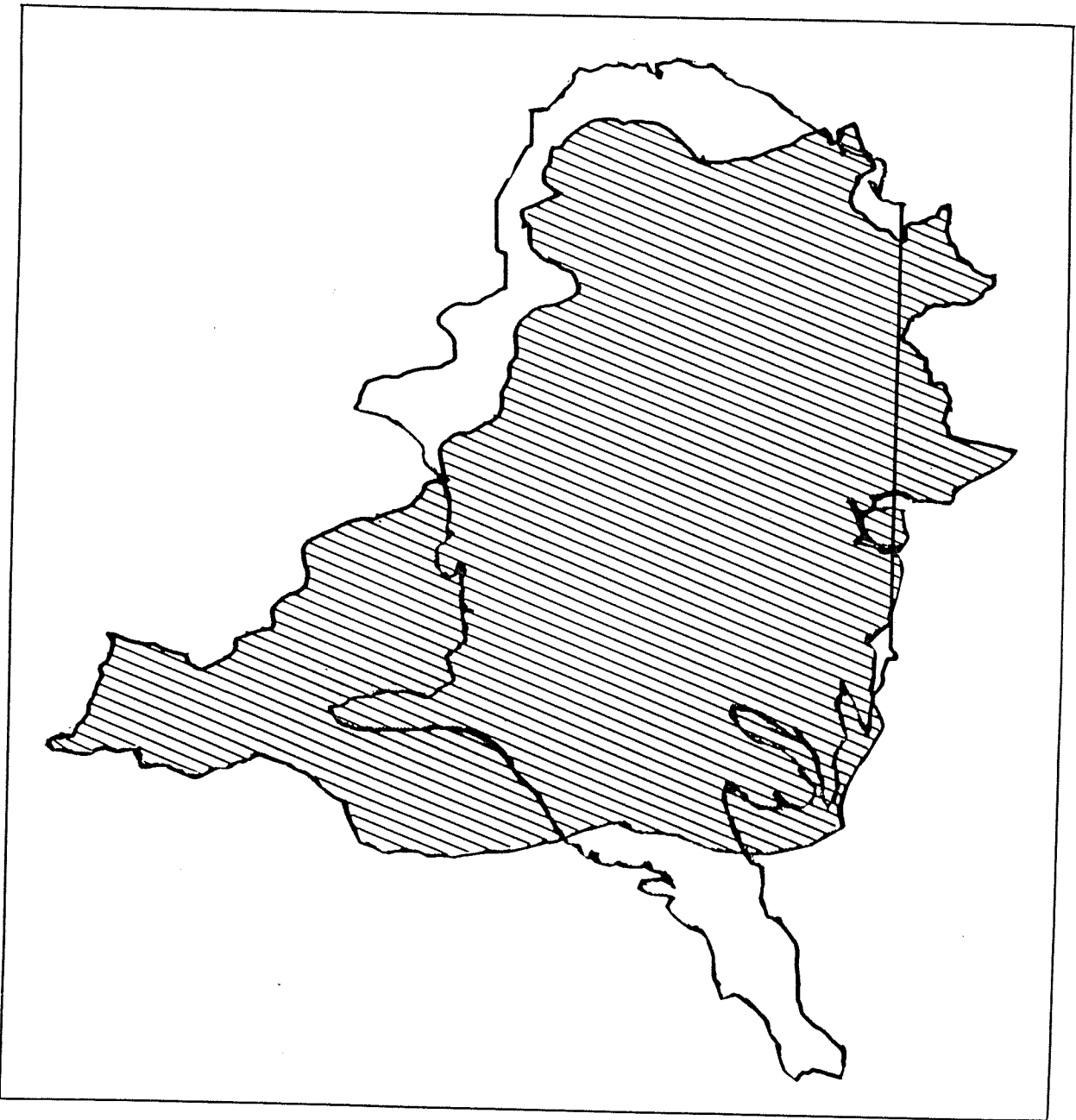


BRAZIL AND THE LOWER 48 OF THE U.S.

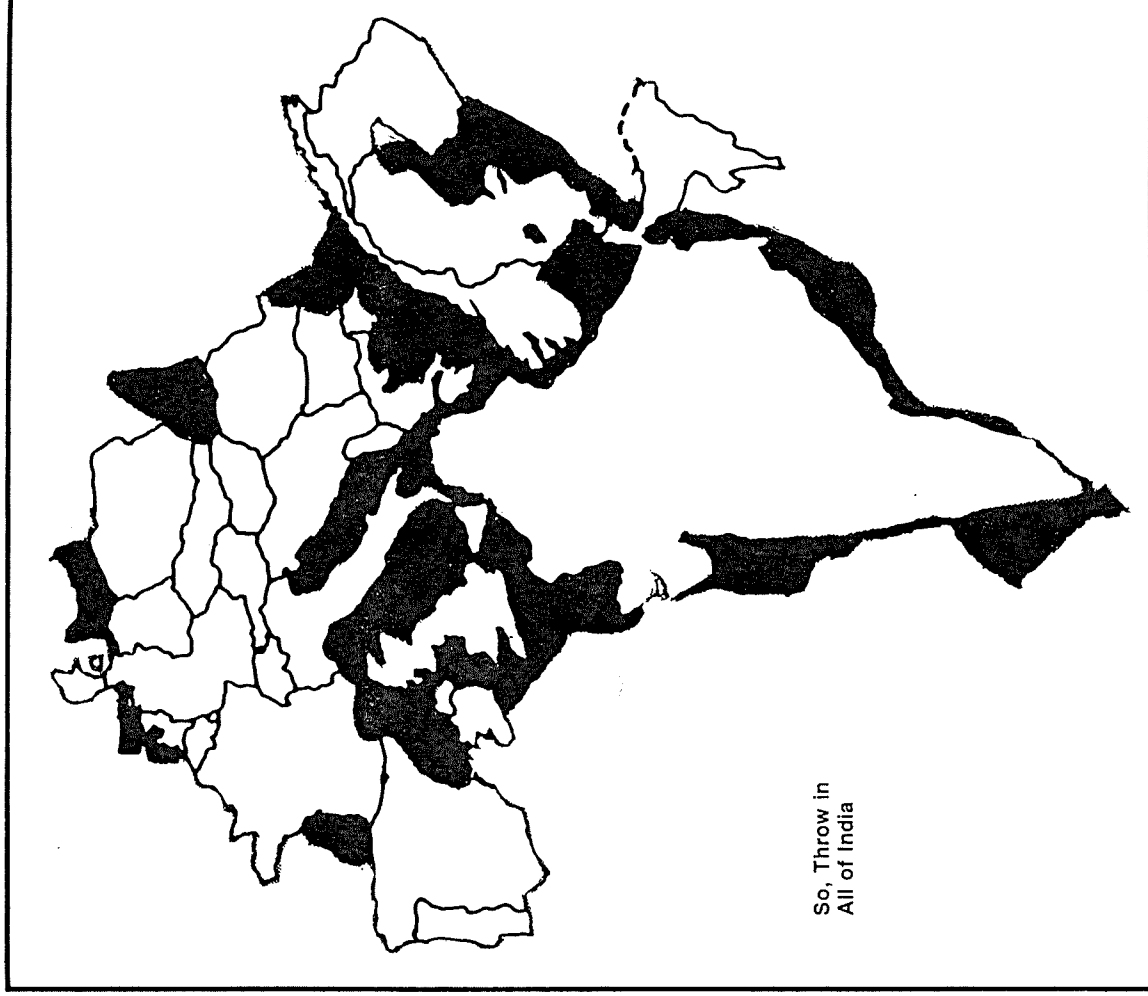
Land Area of all 50 States

—and there would still be 372,595 sq km to spare which is about the area of Costa Rica (50,898 sq km), Guatemala (108,889 sq km), and Honduras (112,088 sq km) combined. Or, in the US, almost the size of the State of California (404,815 sq km).
